- Provide plants for food

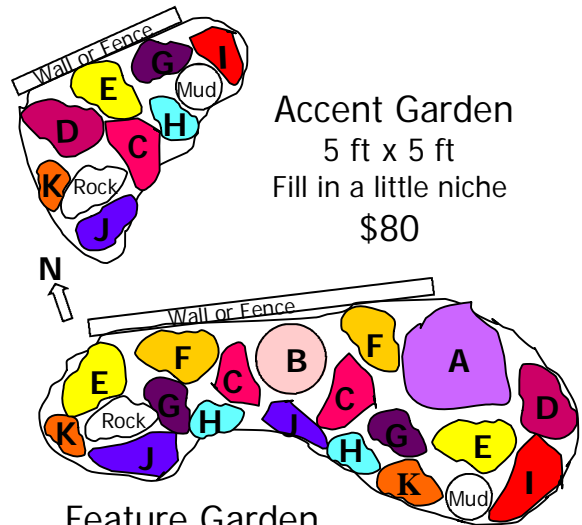
Remember that butterflies come from eggs and caterpillars, so go easy on any sprays.

Perennials:

- A– Buddleia (Butterfly Bush)
 Alternative: Asclepias (Butterfly Milkweed)
- B– Eupatorium (Joe-Pye Weed)
 Alternative: Aster
- C– Dianthus Bouquet series
 Alternative: Garden Phlox
- D– Echinacea (Cone flower)
 Alternative: Mammoth Mum
- E– Coreopsis (Tickseed)
- F– Rudbeckia (Black-eyed Susan)
- G– Scabiosa (Pin-cushion flower)
- H– Sedum (Stonecrop)

Annuals (need to replant each year):

- I– Pentas
- J– Verbena
- K– Lantana
