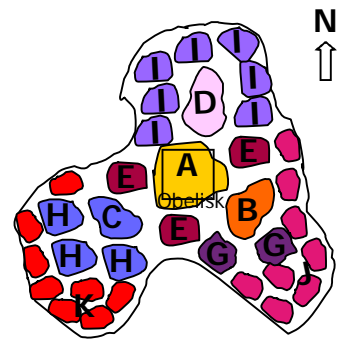
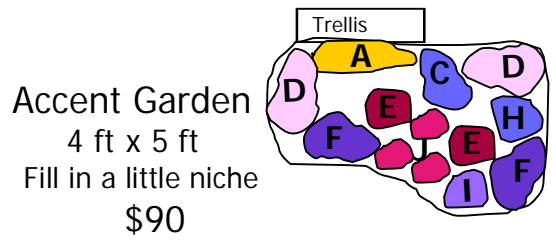




Hummingbird Garden

Perennials:

- A- Campsis (Trumpet Vine)
Alternative: Lonicera (Honeysuckle Vine)
- B- Hemerocallis (Daylily)
- C- Delphinium (Larkspur)
- D- Penstemon (Beardtongue)
- E- Aquilegia (Columbine)
- F- Veronica (Speedwell)
- G- Iris
- H- Lupine
- I- Lavender

Annuals (need to replant each year):

- J- Nicotiana
- K- Salvia
